Mexican Mango Tommy

Scientific Name: *Mangifera Indica*.

Family: Anacardiaceas The mango tree is a tree with dense shade, perennial foliage and medium growth. Its straight trunk whose diameter can reach 75–100 cm, reaching heights of 10 to 90 meters in height. The fruit is a single seed (monosperm) with a fleshy and fibrous mesocarp that surrounds the endocarp (seed). It has an edible mesocarp of different thickness according to the ciliary and the cultivation conditions, its weight varies between 150 Gr. And 2 Kg, its shape is also variable but it is generally Ovoid.







Mangoes are collected within the green stage for transportation without allowing the product to mature quickly, which implies a color change in the skin of the fruit, from dark to light green. If a ruto is picked up quickly, its flavor is negatively affected. Therefore it is important to be able to define the state of minimum maturity.

Weight

In the international market, mangoes with weights between 250 and 600 Gr are preferred, the 4000 Gr is the one that corresponds to 12 gauge mango, which is the ideal gauge that allows us to place and accommodate 12 fruits in the box of carton of five kg of gross weight.

Packaging standards:

One box of each 2 Piece cardboard sheet with lid
